- 10:30am ***Fools “O” and La!La!*** at the Lyric Stage. Physical comedy and mime.
- 11:00am ***Knightwings: Birds of Prey*** at the Blackfriars Theatre. Educational and entertaining birds of prey show.
- 11:30am ***Captain NoBeard’s Mythical Beasts*** at Gatehouse Stage. Captain NoBeard explains mythical creatures with the help of puppets!
- 12:00pm ***DeBracey Productions Equestrian show and Joust*** at Joust Arena. Trick riding, games of skill and jousting! Interpreted area: last row of benches close to the reviewing stand on the left as you face the reviewing stand.
- 12:15pm ***Les S. Moore: Oops! All Danger!*** At Gatehouse Stage. One man comedy show involving whips and other danger!
- 12:30pm ***Vixens En Garde*** at the Market Stage. Three-woman show featuring comedy, swordplay and Shakespeare.
- 1:15pm ***Barely Balanced.*** At Blackfriars Theatre. 3-person comedy and acrobatics show.
- 1:45pm: ***Famous Death Scenes with NoBeard and Gwendolyn.*** At Lyric Stage. Comedy show featuring Shakespeare and swordplay.
- 2:00pm ***Queen of Hoops*** at the Globe. One woman hula-hoop show.
- 2:15pm ***Children’s Knighting Ceremony*** at Fortune Stage. The King knights all goodly children in a general ceremony and then is available for pictures.
- 2:45pm ***Jacob D’Eustachio: Lord of the Sword.*** At Lyric Stage. One-man comedy and juggling show.
- 3:30pm ***Heart & Hazard.*** At Fortune Stage. Two-person show featuring sideshow tricks such as sword swallowing.
- 4:00pm ***The London Broil*** at the Royal Fox Theatre. Three-man comedy and juggling show.
- 4:15pm ***The Topsy Turvy Show*** at Fortune Stage. Two-woman acrobatic and comedy show.
- 4:45pm ***Paolo Garbanzo*** at the Royal Fox Theatre. One man juggling and variety skills show.
