

The Knight

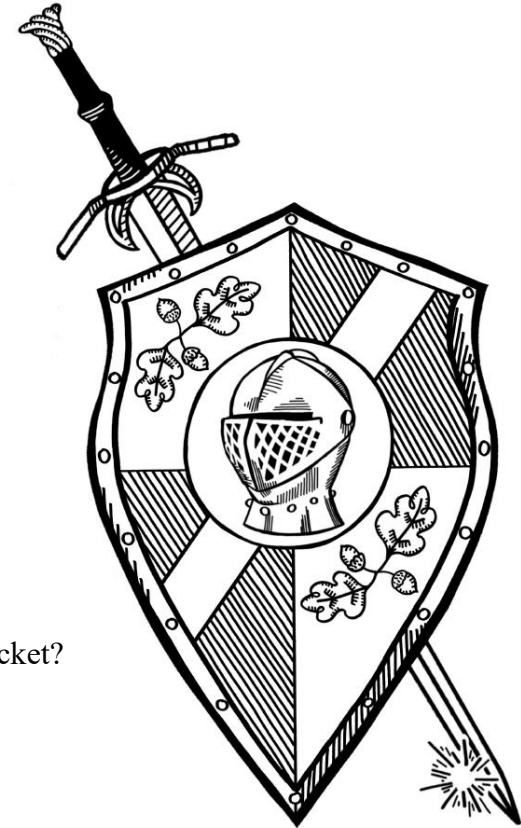
Definition: A warrior, abides by a code of chivalry, a champion, likes action, adventure and variety shows!

September 26th & 27th

SHOWS: *Check the program schedule for exact times and locations.*

- *11am at the Joust field: Militia Mayhem. History and demonstration of weapons.
- *The Jousts, of course: at 12pm, 3pm & 6pm. Seats fill quickly, arrive early!
- *Albannach and SYR, two high-octane Celtic bands at Blackfriars
- *The Rogues at the Market Stage.
- *Piper Jones Band at Market Stage. Pipes and drums!
- *The London Broil, 3-man comedy juggling show at The Royal Fox Theatre
- *Les S. Moore: Oops! All Danger show at the Gatehouse stage at 12:15pm
- *The Company of Women presents a scene from The Three Musketeers at 12:30pm at the Globe Theatre.
- *Visit the birds at the mews near Dragon's Lair, and see a Knightwings Birds of Prey show at Blackfriars or the Joust Arena.
- *Music at the White Hart and Boars Head Tavern. Lots of rousing folk and celtic tunes.
- *Militia Weapons Demos and Swords of Shakespeare at the Grounds for Defense.
- *Dash Rippington's Dangerously Stupid show, twice daily at Lyric Stage (-PG)
- *Martika" One-Woman Stunt show at the Fortune Stage. (if you aren't squeamish)
- *3:15pm at the Lyric Stage it's Captain NoBeard's Pirate Escape. Can he get out of a straitjacket?
- *Visit the Militia tent near the Joust field and talk weapons and more!
- *Here late? Finish your day at Pub Sing at the White Hart Tavern at 5:45pm or perhaps you'd like to dance with Piper Jones at Boars Head at 6:15pm.
